### DESCRIPTION

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#### ORIENTATION TO KEY CONCEPTS IN SOCIAL ROLE VALORIZATION & PASSING

This new workshop combines classroom learning with hands-on experience as part of a team observing & learning from an actual human service program. The workshop teaches about:

- The immediate & long-term devastating impacts of social devaluation
- How getting socially valued roles (in the neighborhood, at work, in social & leisure opportunities) opens the door to the 'good things of life'
- Helping vulnerable people to be embedded in typical community life
- How to structure service settings, activities, relationships & groupings in a beneficial way
- How to evaluate a human service program as to how well or poorly it addresses the needs of service recipients

### TUITION

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\$600 tuition which includes textbook rental, handouts, coffee & lunches.
