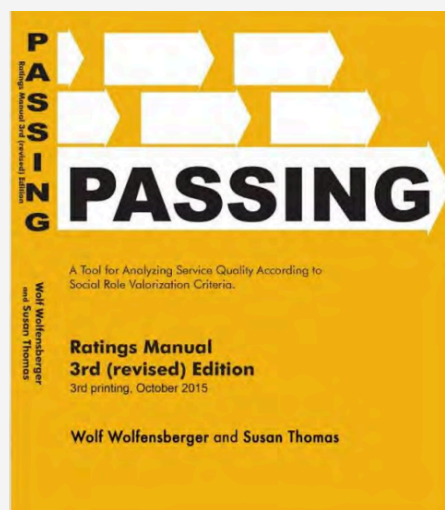

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

The PASSING workshop builds upon the Introduction to Social Role Valorization (SRV) course by providing a hands-on experience with an actual human service program. The workshop emphasizes the impact of services on the lives of their recipients. This is an opportunity to work with the ideas of SRV to craft a vision of excellent service. In this workshop, teams will use the PASSING assessment tool along with their knowledge of the SRV framework to evaluate a residential & a "day" service, visiting with service recipients & conducting interviews with staff & administrators. The event involves extensive personal reflection & analysis, group conciliation, & thought-provoking discussion. The week's work is conducted under the guidance of an experienced team leader & senior trainer. Persons attending PASSING must have first attended a full Introduction to SRV workshop. This workshop includes long days & late nights. Participants may check in on Sunday, March 1, 2026.
